- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m. by Vice-Chair/Acting Chair, Karen Kent and a quorum established.
- 2. Public Comments: There were two members of the public in attendance but no comments were made.
- 3. Newly Appointed Board Director, Scott Nash was present for meeting. Vice-Chair/Acting Chair Karen Kent officially swore in Scott Nash by taking the Oath of Office and completed with signature during the regular scheduled meeting with Becca Moore, Moore Insurance Agency, to sign off as witness for receipt of Director Bond.
- 4. Motion by Vivian Foster to approve as written August 14, 2025 Special Called Meeting Minutes, August 20, 2025 Special Called Meeting Minutes, and August 27, 2025 Meeting Minutes and approved amended August 14, 2025 Regular Meeting Minutes with correction made on #10 for Karen Kent to be named authorizer to sign Forvis commitment letter. Second by Susan Anderson. All in favor. Motion carried.
- 5. Motion by Paulette Cooper to approve payroll from August 16 31, 2025 and September 1 15, 2025 as presented. Second by Susan Anderson. All in favor. Motion carried.
- 6. Mr. Will Thomas was not present for his scheduled presentation.
- 7. Discussion began regarding Adopting the Effective No New Tax Rate, beginning with Vice-Chair/Acting Chair, Karen Kent reading the presented Resolution. Motion was made by Vivian Foster to Adopt the No New Tax Rate of \$0.0388280 per \$100.00 value. Second by Paulette Cooper. In favor were Susan Anderson, Vivian Foster, Paulette Cooper, Scott Nash, Karen Kent and opposed by Michelle Ready. Motion carried and Resolution was signed accordingly.

- 9. Discussion began on CD rate list and it was brought up by Vice-Chair/Acting Chair, Karen Kent, that money would need to be moved to VeraBank checking account in the near future.
